The Assistant U.S. Attorney who was assigned the lead role in the case was Renai Rodney. On Aug 6, 2009 an Indictment was filed in the U.S. District Court. The case was assigned to Federal District Court Judge James Block Zagel.

Following a jury trial, the defendant was sentenced to prison for 0 years, 292 months, and 0 days on Jul 18, 2012 by Federal District Court Judge James Block Zagel.
